Notes: (1) a successful petition represents 30% of the current households in the neighborhood where traffic calming is proposed. For example if a subdivision has 100 homes or lots then current representatives from at least 30 homes/lots must sign the petition. The number of lots in the neighborhood or subdivision is typically established by the recorded subdivision plat map. (2) This petition is the first step in the process to allow physical traffic calming devices to be installed in a neighborhood and authorizes county staff to permit a traffic calming plan to be implemented in a neighborhood. Prior to installation of any traffic calming devices majority of the households must approve a plan through a second vote or petition.
